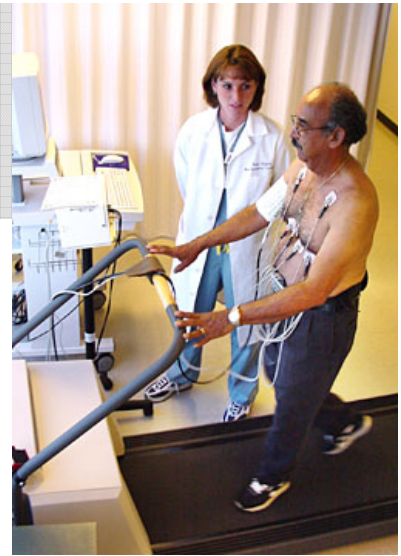
Introduction

The analysis of rhythm strips is an important part of the care of cardiac patients. This seminar reviews the physiology involved in the electrical system of the heart and then explains the mechanism behind the formation of rhythms. The session incorporates not only rhythm recognition but also clinical presentations and potential treatment modalities used in clinical practice today. An extensive handout is included with a multitude of strips. Dynamic rhythm recognition and case study review is also used.

(Please note: This seminar is a comprehensive rhythm review for participants who have a basic understanding of dysrhythmias. For facilities needing beginning rhythm recognition, alternate sessions can be provided with additional instruction and practice sessions.)

Objectives

1. State the basics of ECG monitoring and evaluating a rhythm strip.
2. Recognize the rhythms associated with the sinus node and any clinical manifestations and treatment.
3. Verbalize an understanding of the rhythms originating from atrial tissue and appropriate treatment.
4. Verbalize an understanding of the rhythms originating from the junction, clinical manifestations, and appropriate treatment.
5. Differentiate between the various heart blocks seen in the clinical setting, causes, and treatment modalities.
6. State the difference between the ventricular dysrhythmias and the appropriate treatment for each rhythm.
7. Recognize the various rhythm patterns that can be seen in patients with temporary or permanent pacemakers.
